The Ocelot first emerged from Clan Nova Cat's factories a few years after their defection to the Inner Sphere. Lightweight and highly mobile, this 'Mech's typical load of lasers, heat sinks, and excellent armor protection for its size made it an ideal hunter-killer during the Jihad. NC516-13E, in fact, was configured as a medium-range brawler, with enough firepower to cripple other light 'Mechs in a single volley and a targeting computer for added accuracy. This 'Mech saw action on Buckminster and Vega (Combine worlds hit hardest by the Blakist zealots) before its warrior followed Stone into his Republic of the Sphere.

Rob Hoge, the latest MechWarrior to inherit this particular Ocelot, has nicknamed it "Hothead" for the quirky behavior of its Clan-made heavy large laser. Though he complains about the weapon's disruptive effects on his onboard systems in battle, Hoge's proficiency with it is nearly legendary.
